Since 2008, certain courses published in the Collected Courses series have also individually been published as pocketbooks and as e-books at a lower price, with the aim of making them accessible to a wider public and, in particular, to students.

MONOGRAPH

This series contains updated and republished versions of specific courses previously published in the Collected Courses.

THE WORK OF THE CENTRE FOR STUDIES AND RESEARCH

Since 2000, the work of the Centre has been published in a collection that includes both the reports of the two Directors and the best papers that have been written under their direction by the young research students. These papers are presented in accordance with the scientific logic of the general outline that has guided the work, and thus provide a logically ordered series of studies on the overall topic.

COLLOQUIA

These bring together a small group of specialists on the subject being studied. Their main interest, in addition to bringing together academics, diplomats and practitioners who have a common background and competency in a particular area, is that they result in a scientific publication, in the collection of *Colloquia of the Academy*. They have covered a large variety of topics.
